[UnionM21](#) - The Union is the main co-operative catalogue in Base.

UnionM21 has been built over many years by professional cataloguers in libraries all over the UK. This database is a treasure trove of rare, old and out-of-print records as well as quality catalogue records for mainstream items.

[BDSBkM21](#) - BDS is one of the UK's premiere sources of commercially supplied bibliographic records.

This database is comprised of their uk book cataloguing and use of the data from here is covered by the Public Library License that BDS charge.

BDS supplied records covering audio and visual materials for a wide range of music, film, audiobook and multimedia publications.

[BLConM21](#) - British Library Consolidated database.

The British Library's main catalogue containing records for over 12 million books, serials, printed music and maps. As the name suggests, this is a consolidation of BNB, HSS, STI (formerly SRIS), Document, Supply Centre Monographs, Document Supply Centre, Conferences, Serials, Music, Maps.

LC's entire MARC database for book cataloging. Features catalog records for print monographs written in nearly all the world's languages and published anywhere. Includes Cataloging in Publication (CIP) records and minimal level cataloging records. Records for monographs published in non-roman alphabets provide cataloging data in romanized form only.

[LCComM21 - Library of Congress Computer Files.](#)

The Library of Congress' entire Computer Files collection consisting of Cataloguing records for machine-readable data files and computer software.

[LCMapM21 - Library of Congress Maps.](#)

The Library of Congress' entire Maps collection consisting of Single and multi-sheet maps, map sets, and maps treated as serials.

[LCMusM21 - Library of Congress Music.](#)

The Library of Congress' entire Music collection consisting of printed and manuscript music and for music and non-music sound recordings.

[LCSerM21 - Library of Congress Serials.](#)

The Library of Congress' entire Serials collection consisting of CONSER serials either catalogued or processed by LC or by CONSER (Cooperative Online Serials Program) participants.

[LCVisM21 - Library of Congress Visual Materials.](#)

The Library of Congress' entire Visual Materials collection consisting of MARC records for all motion pictures, video recordings, filmstrips, transparencies, slides, and non-projectable graphics catalogued by LC. Records include all languages.

[NLMCatM21 - National Library of Medicine Books.](#)

The US National Library of Medicines' catalogue includes NLM cataloguing records and all monograph and monograph chapter records created by contributing collaborative partners in the fields of history of medicine, health technology assessment, space, bioethics, and population studies. This data distribution replaces the distribution of monographs and chapter records previously found in HISTLINE, HealthSTAR, SPACELINE, BIOETHICSLINE, and POPLINE. Records from all collaborative partners are integrated with NLM cataloguing records created in the same timeframe and distributed in a single product.

NLMSerM21 - National Library of Medicine Serials.

The US National Library of Medicines' collection contains all serial bibliographic records in LocatorPlus, whether or not they have been catalogued by NLM. This is the MARC-formatted successor to the NLM's former SERLINE product and contains some additional NLM indexing-related data familiar to former SERLINE users in NLM locally-defined fields.

OCLC - CILLA.

The Co-operative of Indic Language Library Authorities (CILLA) is a subscription service which assists libraries to meet the needs of their Indic Communities by providing an acquisitions and cataloguing service for Indic Language Materials. The Languages covered are Bengali from Bangladesh and India, Gujarati, Hindi, Panjabi, Tamil from India & Sri Lanka and Urdu from India and Pakistan.

TSOM21 - The Stationery Office.

Government titles covering a very broad range of topics including the economy, work and welfare, health, transport and the environment. There are two main groups of documents: Command Papers (sometimes known as White or Green Papers) and House of Commons Papers. The latter category includes many Annual Reports from Government bodies including all the principal Executive Agencies and the annual Financial Statement and Budget Report and Pre-Budget Report.
